Goals and Objectives:

- Educate the community about the age of various buildings within the Cleveland Park Historic District
- Instill a sense of pride and respect in the neighborhood and its historic architecture
- Educate the public at large about the extent of the Historic District and its boundaries

Criteria:

- Properties in the Cleveland Park Historic District that were built in 1941 or earlier (contributing resources in the Historic District)
- Individually-landmarked properties within the Cleveland Park Historic District

Process:

- Contact us at staff@clevelandparkhistoricalsociety.org to find out if your property is eligible. We will advise you on documenting the age of your structure.
- Complete the attached application form.
- Mail form along with a check for **\$200 per marker (manufacturing cost plus shipping) for CPHS members / \$250 per marker for non-members to the Cleveland Park Historical Society, P.O. Box 4862, Washington, DC 20008.**
- Applications for markers will be taken at anytime during the year. To help reduce the cost of the markers and to realize savings from bulk orders, plaques will be fabricated and shipped only once a minimum number of requests are on hand.
